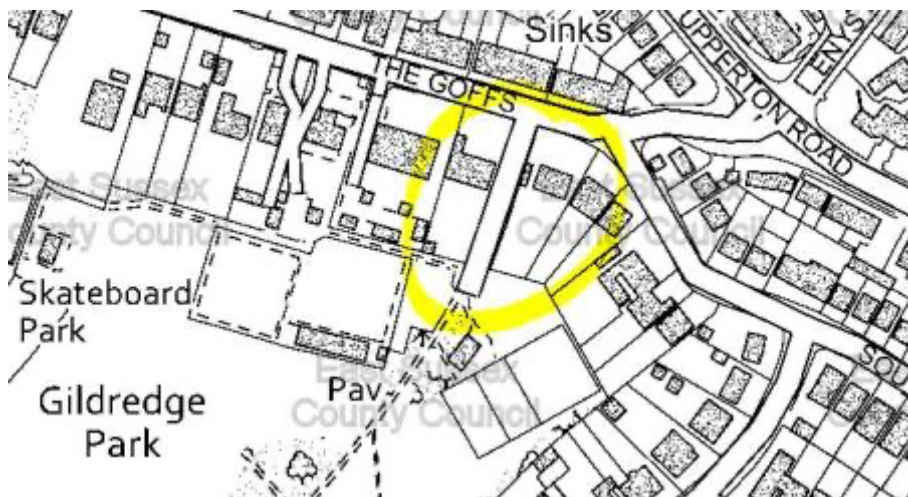


BEACHY HEAD RAMBLERS
Claiming Unregistered Rights of Way

Do you walk into Gildredge Park using this pavement from The Goffs?



You may have heard that at the beginning of 2026 many paths that existed before 1949 but are not on the official rights of way map will lose their public rights.

This path is on the North East side of the park.

This path is well used, but it is not on the rights of way map. We want to put it on the map.

We must stress that there is no immediate threat to the paths but we want them to be safe for future generations. We can put the route on the map by showing that people have used the path without restraint for the past 20 years as a through route. We do this by asking people to fill in forms giving evidence of their use of the paths.

A form you can fill in is attached.

If you know of anyone else who has used the route please let them know about this.

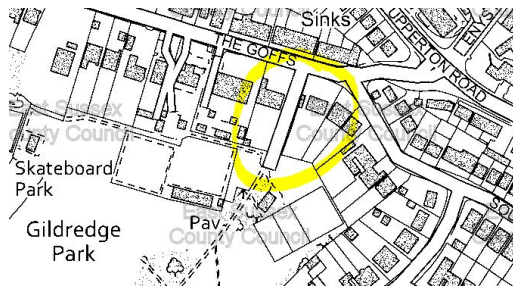
